FOR STARTERS

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
2. How can you portray patience during your suffering?
3. Does God answer every prayer? If no, why not?

DIGGING IN

1. Why is patience important for your walk in Christ?
2. How can you as a believer overcome the temptation to grumble with others when things aren't going well?
3. What does James say about earnest prayer?
4. Read Job 42:7-17. What do you see as an important lesson about God and Job's relationship?
5. How will you encourage your family, friends, co-workers and life group members to be more Christ-like?

BRINGING IT HOME

1. What does James mean when he says in James 5:12, "*...do not swear - not by heaven or by earth or by anything else...*"?
2. Do you **P**ray **U**ntil **S**omething **H**appens (PUSH)?
3. This week:
 - a. Call someone who you know is troubled and pray with them.
 - b. Find someone in your Life Group who is "happy" and rejoice with them.
