

2018-19 Ministry Year Service Trips

Haiti

Dates: October 24-31, 2018

Partner: Mission of Hope

Approx. Cost: \$1,800

What Doing: Visiting a school in Zorange to establish relationships and work with the children there. Learning about sustainable agriculture practices in Haiti and how that is impacting child nutrition, painting and other restoration projects at our partner school, and packing meals for students in nearby schools.

Haiti

Dates: November 1-3, 2018

Partner: Mission of Hope

Approx. Cost: \$1,500

What Doing: Visiting a school in Zorange to continue to grow relationships. Learning about various aspects of Mission of Hope's work in Haiti. Planting trees to provide future shade and fruit for families and communities.

Haiti

Dates: January 15-18, 2019

Partner: Mission of Hope

Approx. Cost: \$600

What Doing: Door Creekers and representatives of our partner schools are joining Numana on a trip to Haiti to see how meal packaging events (like ours last year) have changed the lives of so many people. This trip will give insight into the international organizations that Numana partners with all over the world.

New Orleans

Dates: January 2019 (exact dates TBD)

Partner: Urban Impact

Approx. Cost: \$650

What Doing: Completing needed projects, including minor construction projects like painting, flooring, cleaning, etc. There will also be the opportunity to assist with tutoring during the organization's after-school programming.

Rwanda

Dates: March 14-23, 2019

Partner: World Relief

Approx. Cost: \$3,500

What Doing: Learning about the history of Rwanda, visiting the genocide memorial, preparing for and leading a leadership development training and retreat for local Rwandan pastors and their spouses.

Partner: Red Cloud Indian School

Approx. Cost: \$450

What Doing: Spending time with local leaders and students within the school to gain insight into where Door Creek might come alongside Pine Ridge in the future to make sure service trips are helping Red Cloud Indian School further their own mission.

What Doing: Visiting the CDI school program, learning about the medical clinic, assisting with sustainable farming, building a home and bunk beds for students, and continuing to grow relationships with local staff and community members.
