FOR STARTERS

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
2. Share one high and one low from this past week.
3. Do you see yourself as a glass half-full or half-empty kind of person?

DIGGING IN

1. Read Romans 5:1-11. What words or phrases jump out? Why?
2. What is Paul saying about our identity in verses 1-2? What is then our response in verse 3-4?
3. How does Paul view suffering in this passage? How does he relate it to hope?
4. What point is Paul making in verses 6-8?
5. How are verses 9-11 about hope?

BRINGING IT HOME

1. What does it practically mean for you to "stand in grace" moment by moment?
2. Tell your story. How have you seen God work to transform your life?
3. What practical implications might there be if we fully find our hope in Christ alone?
