ROMANS | DEATH TO LIFE

DEC. 8/9 | ROMANS 6:1-7:6

FOR STARTERS

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged you or raised questions?
2. A couple of you share your story of "where you came from" and how that impacts how you live your life today.

DIGGING IN

1. Read Romans 6:1-4. What is Paul's argument here, why shouldn't we go on sinning?
2. Read Romans 6:5-11.
 - What does it mean to no longer be slaves to sin? (Look at verse 20 as well.)
 - Read Galatians 5:24. What does it mean to be crucified with Christ?
 - How do we live out verse 11?
3. Read Romans 6:12-18. How does Paul use slave and freedom here? What does it mean to be slaves to God?
4. Read Romans 6:20-23. Paul draws a contrast between two ways of life. What are they and does this contrast motivate us to obey God?

BRINGING IT HOME

1. If you only had five minutes to convince a Christian friend not to choose sin, using Romans 6, what 2-3 things could you say?
2. What area in your life are you prone to presume on the grace of God? What does it look like to consider yourself dead to those desires and what does it look like to serve God in this area?
3. What does it look like to offer everything you are, and everything you have, back to God? Look at Romans 12:1-9 for more.
4. Pray, thanking God for Jesus and asking God to help you live out your grace identity in everyday life.
