FOR STARTERS

2. As a group, list the ways that denial has manifested in your lives and shown itself as your enemy.

DIGGING IN

1. What other stories from Scripture can you see denial at play?
2. In these stories, how does God's grace, forgiveness and restoration unfold?
3. Read Psalm 119:25-32. Why do you think the author placed deception in the middle of these verses?
4. Read the following Scriptures and write down what you learn about God's grace. Romans 11:6; Ephesians 2:8; Hebrews 4:16
5. After reading the following Scriptures, how should we respond? James 4:6; 1 John 1:9; Proverbs 28:13; James 5:16
6. How do the following verses help us to become aware of our denial as we stop and listen? Psalm 139; 2 Timothy 3:16,17; Psalm 19:7-9

BRINGING IT HOME

1. Right now, schedule a time to stop and listen this week.
2. From the message this week, what is God asking you to do regarding denial in your life and how can this group help you?
3. How can we encourage each other in a way that reflects how God encourages us?
4. How does our relationship with God through Christ free us from denial?
5. How can Psalm 119:29 become a constant prayer throughout your day and in your spiritual journey?
