"My wife Vicky was diagnosed with cancer in 2010. In 2011, she stood in front of Door Creek Church thanking God for providing us a church family to help get her through it. What we didn't know at the time was that her cancer wasn't gone. Four month later, she passed away.

Instead of walking away from God after the loss of my wife, I've actually grown more in my faith. God's mercy and grace have gotten me to this point.

"Funds provided buckets and bleach to help prevent the spread of Ebola. We balanced between physical and spiritual needs and our mission was to reach out to people and give them hope. "We all will die, but when you die, where will you be?" That created hope. If I caught Ebola and died today, yet knew Jesus Christ, I would be OK."
