Psalm 100 | Enter into His Presence

"Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth." Psalm 100:1

In life, how we enter a place can speak volumes about our character and demeanor. It can lead one to determine how serious they should take us or respect us.

In the Psalms reading this week, we will look at the *instructions given to us on how we should come* before God's presence and how we should behave before Him. We should drape ourselves in joy and gladness because of who He is and because of His awesome presence.
