

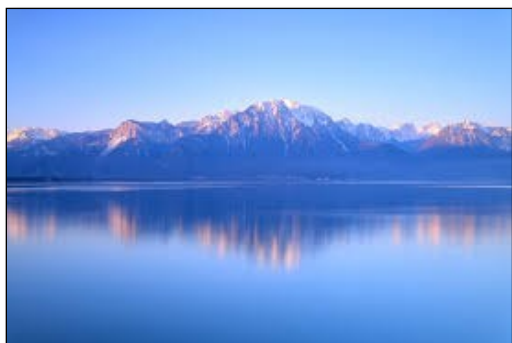
Door Creek Church | Devotional Plan

Wednesday, April 15

Psalm 121 | The Lord is Watching Over You - He Will Watch Over Your Life!

Every Sunday morning Lori and I and the kids would jump in the minivan and head down the mountain toward Lausanne. We were heading to Scots Kirk, a small Scottish Presbyterian church, that we called home while we lived in Switzerland for six months.

Psalm 121 was one of the Psalms we memorized with the kids on our half-hour trek. I'll never forget driving toward Lake Geneva and seeing the Alps and reciting, "I lift up my



eyes to the mountains – where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth."



His help is as big and certain as mountain - we can count on it!

We are being oh so vigilant right now to NOT get Covid-19. We are taking extra care to make sure we are taking every precaution. How wonderful to read that God is not only our helper, but He is watching over us and God never sleeps on the job. He watches our very steps (v 3) and says He'll watch over our whole life (v 7). **God's care and help are with us both now and forevermore.**

Whenever we read a section of Scripture and wonder if this is a promise, saying if you turn to God for help you will never be harmed, not even Covid-19, we need to think through how this same Scripture worked out for Jesus. In other words, Jesus' foot didn't slip, even though He was crucified, God didn't fall asleep when He was laid in Joseph's tomb – God watched over Jesus' life and God is watching over yours and mine, today and forever.

Take comfort that He sees your every step and that our good Father who gave us Jesus is watching over your life today.
