CARE PARTNERS

Care Givers: A Care Giver provides confidential, one-on-one Christ-centered care for those hurting or going through major life changes through listening, prayer and Bible-based encouragement. Care Givers are trained individuals who have responded to Christ's call to "carry each other's burdens and in this way you will fulfill the mission of Christ."

Become a Care Giver: Care Giver applications are due August 1. A Care Giver completes 30 hours of training before being matched with a Care Receiver. Training classes are held September - December each year. He or she learns about listening, assertiveness, confidentiality, boundaries, grief, spiritual growth and other aspects of care giving.

Care Receivers: Care Receivers are people experiencing loneliness, discouragement, a faith crisis or major life changes such as divorce, loss of a loved one, retirement, unemployment, childbirth, hospitalization or terminal illness. They are matched with a Care Giver.

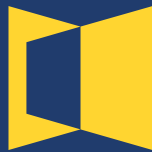
