Care Givers provide confidential, one-on-one Christ-centered care for those hurting or going through major life changes through listening, prayer and Bible-based encouragement to a Care Receiver.

Become a Care Giver: A Care Giver completes 30 hours of training before being matched with a Care Receiver. They learn about listening, assertiveness, confidentiality, boundaries, grief, spiritual growth and other aspects of care giving. Training classes are held September through December each year and applications are due August 1.
